SFA SOUTH EAST REGION U11 GIRLS FOOTBALL 2010

These are very exciting times and there are now more and more opportunities for girls to become involved in football participation across not only the South East Region, but across Scotland as a whole. As you may be aware we formalised the U11 girls programme in 2009 to host five Regional Festivals for the South East which have been very successful.

Following several meetings recently, clubs are very keen to formalise the U11 girls activity further for 2010. The plan for 2010 will be as follows;

1. West Lothian U11 Girls Section (bi-weekly fixtures for March . November with July Break)
2. Scottish Borders U11 Girls Section (bi-weekly fixtures for March . November with July Break)
3. Edinburgh, Midlothian and East Lothian Section (bi-weekly fixtures for March . November with July Break)

Until we have an idea of the entries we will not be able to confirm exact formats , ie. Festivals or home-away fixtures or combination of both. Once we have this information we will be in touch as soon as possible. There is no fee attached to these events in the first instance and the SFA South East Region will pay for all U11 girls teams affiliation fees to the SWF where teams enter before the end of January 2010. We are also offering a free coach education place to coaches who enter teams (worth £30-£45). Please note that teams must be registered to the SWF for insurance purposes.

The proposed game formats will be 4-aside until the summer then either 4-aside or 7-aside after the break depending on feedback from team coaches.
